## **ABC Book Report**

- You will need to use each of the letters in the alphabet to represent something, someone, or some idea from the book that you have read. When writing your phrases make sure you are including:
  - character
  - setting
  - □ time
  - □ plot
  - theme
- The phrase must start with that letter of the alphabet and must be unique to each letter and idea. (Ideas in phrases cannot be restated.)
- The phrases must have at least eight words in them.
- You need to include at the top of the report the title, author, and genre of the book.
- You must set off the letters of the alphabet, by either putting them in a different font or color.
- The report does not need to be typed, but will need to be handwritten in ink. If you hand write your report donot write on the backsides.
- You may leave 2 of the 26 letters blank, but will receive extra credit if you do all 26 letters.
